ELR Portal COVID-19 Statutory Requirements

- The Electronic Laboratory Reporting Portal is a web-based application that supports both direct manual data entry and batch upload data submission.
- Mandatory reporting requirements are outlined by Florida Department of Health [Emergency Rule 64DER21-8](#) and Florida Administrative Code Chapter 64D-3.
- Practitioners, laboratories, facilities, and all others using point-of-care tests for the diagnosis of COVID-19, including those operating under CLIA waivers, must report both the positive and negative test results to the Department within 24 hours of test administration.



ELR Portal COVID-19 Statutory Requirements


- Per Emergency Rule 64DER20-34, FAC, all test results must be submitted electronically, using one of the electronic reporting methods listed below:
 - Electronic laboratory reporting: generation of an electronic comma separated value (CSV), or Health Level 7 (HL7) formatted message
 - National Healthcare Safety Network COVID-19 module for Centers for Medicare and Medicaid-certified long-term care facilities
 - ELR Result Reporting Portal: for entities that perform COVID-19, Influenza, RSV or Lead Disease testing that are unable to generate an electronic CSV or HL7 formatted message



ELR Portal Registration Process

Finalizing Registration

- After submitting your registration, a link will be sent to the email address provided. Follow the link to confirm your request and receive confirmation of your successful submission.
 - Your request will be reviewed and either approved or rejected. If approved, an invitation email will be sent to finalize your user registration request.
 - If rejected, you will be notified with the reason via email and you can submit a new request with your corrections.
- After registration is finalized, you may begin reporting using the portal reporting link provided.



ELR Portal Data Submission

When ready to report data to the ELR Portal, use the following link: ELRPortal.floridahealth.gov

Direct Data Manual Entry - Test results can be reported by using the direct data manual entry method.

Batch Upload Data Submission - Test results can be reported by using the batch upload data entry method by submitting a .csv or .xlsx file that complies with the provided file format specifications. The format specifications are provided on the ELR portal.
